GEORGE F. THOMAS is Professor of Religious Thought at Princeton University and President of the American Theological Society for next year. His recent book, *Spirit And Its Freedom*, is a study in the philosophy of spirit and its ethical and social implications.

AMOS N. WILDER is Professor of New Testament Interpretation at the Andover Newton Theological School and author of *Eschatology and Ethics in the Teaching of Jesus*.
